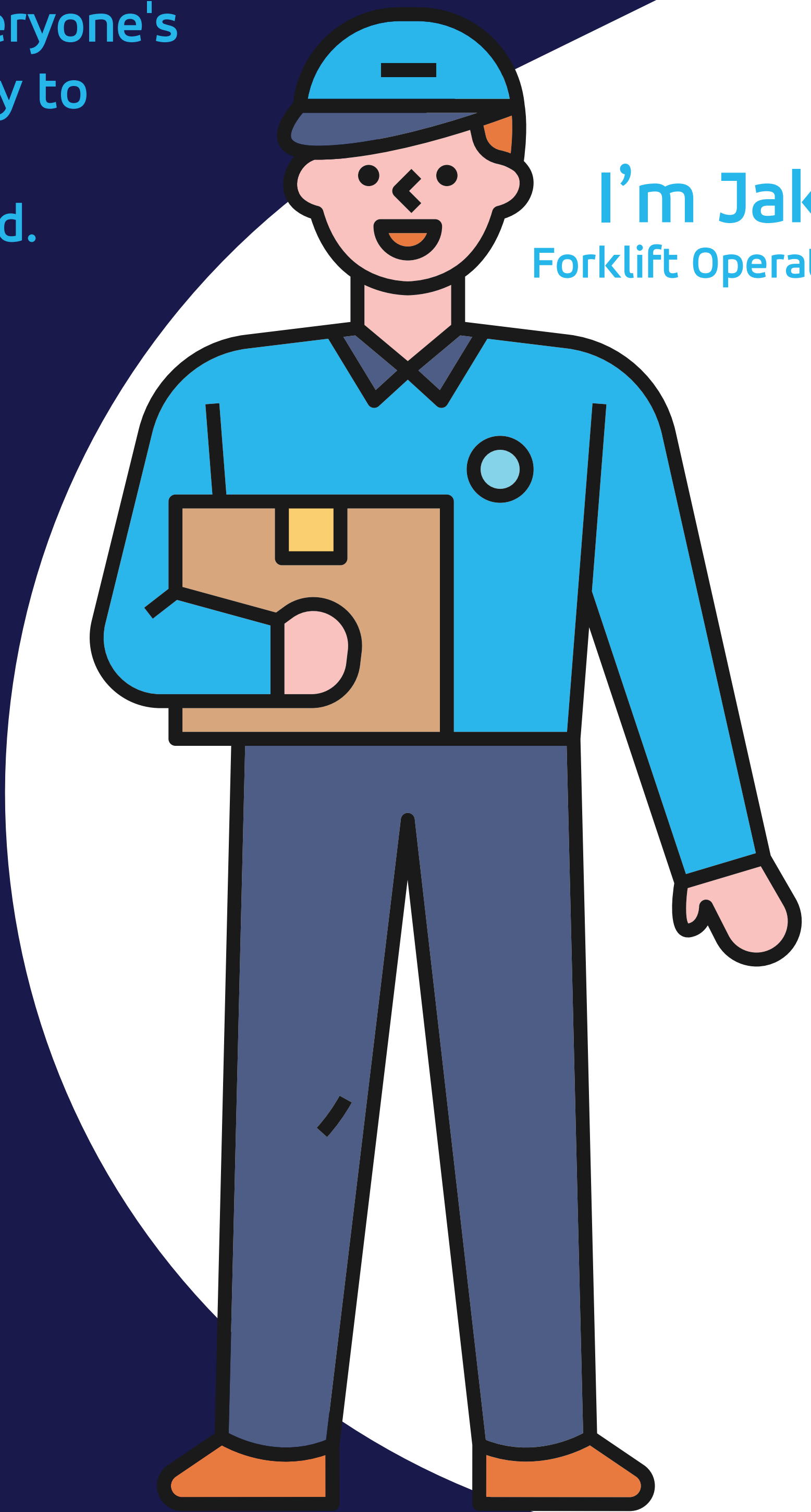
I work to support my family and provide benefits for my kids.
